# Glory of Narasimha

Shri Narsimha Baba Saheb Maharaj's 92nd Aradhana was performed at Maniknagar on 28th May 2015. Shri Narsimha Baba Saheb Maharaj (1881 – 1923 - elder son of Shri Martand Manik Prabhu Maharaj) dedicated his entire life for Prabhu Seva as the Secretary of Shri Manik Prabhu Samsthan. In his short tenure Maniknagar achieved a prominent place in the spiritual and social map of India. He was a great visionary, excellent administrator and a zealous builder with modern and revolutionary ideas. The construction projects of compound walls of Shri Prabhu's Temple and Bhandarkhana along with the Bhojanshala were completed during his period. The magnificent and iconic Mahadwar (Veshi) of Shri Prabhu's Temple was also built by him. He started a bi-monthly magazine by the name "Manik Prabhu" in the year 1918 to propagate the teachings of Sakalamat Sampradaya.



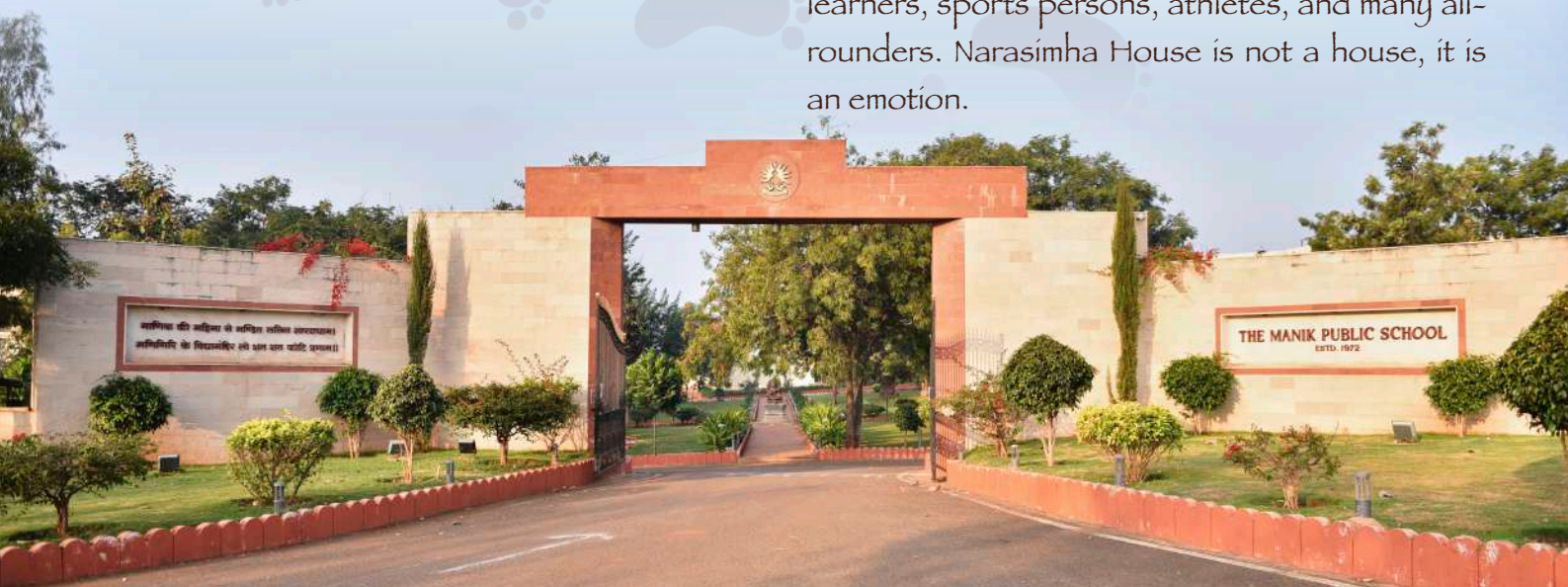
Narasimha House is named after Shri Narasimha Babasaheb Maharaj. Babasaheb Maharaj was the elder son of Shri Martand Manik Prabhu Maharaj. He served as the Secretary of the Samstan and contributed immensely to the development of Maniknagar. He was one of the first people from this region to receive a modern English education and it was his cherished desire that children from our region should receive the same. This desire later materialized in the form of The Manik Public School due the efforts of Shri Siddharaj Manik Prabhu Maharaj.

# The Journey

The crest of the House is the face of a Lion, symbolising another connotation of the word, 'Narasimha'. This motto of the house is "सत्यमेव मृगेंद्रता" which means: "Nobody declares by a lion as the king of the forest coronation. By sheer might and valour of his own; a lion achieves the status of king of the animal kingdom". We all should be grateful to Narasimha Prabhu as he brought English education in this region to us which makes many things happen.

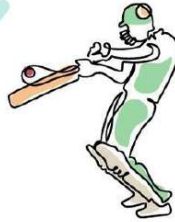

# An Overated Player

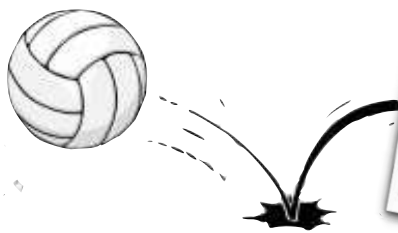
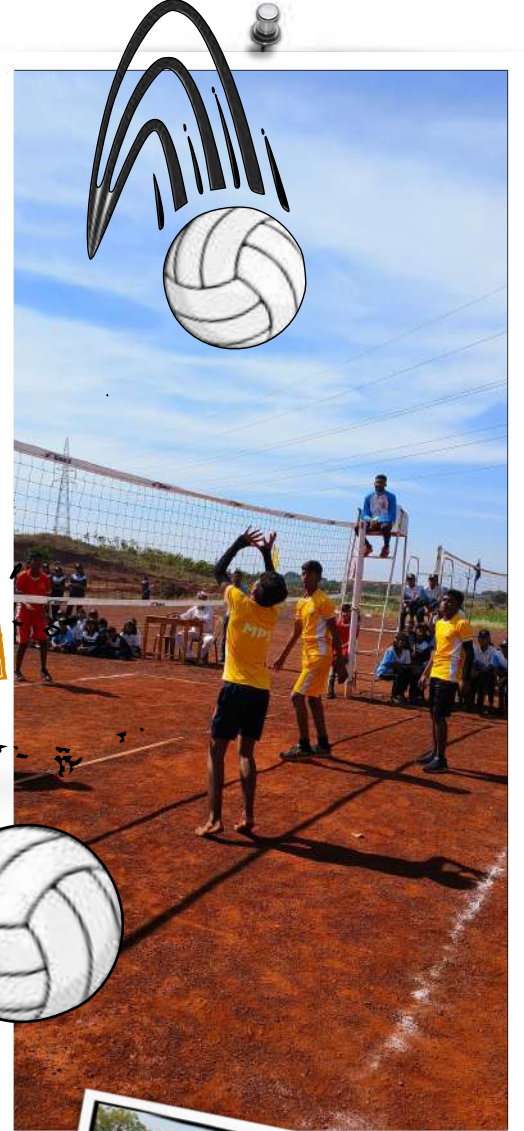
