## Shri Siddharaj Manik Prabhu An Educationist par excellence!

His Holiness Shri Siddharaj Manik Prabhu Maharaj was the Fifth Peethadipati of Shri Manik Prabhu Samsthan, a Spiritual Centre of considerable significance in the Spiritual Map of India. As the Peethadipati of the Samsthan, he shouldered the responsibility of the administrative and organizational affairs and the spiritual practices of the Samsthan since he assumed his position as the head of the Samsthan in 1945, at the tender age of six.

His pre - Schooling and Primary Schooling years were spent on the red soil of Maniknagar, that he loved so well. He attended the Manik Vidyalaya, the first formal School in Manik Nagar, established by his father and the Fourth Peethadipati of Shri Manik Prabhu Samsthan, Shri Shankar Manik Prabhu, a progressive thinker, who laid the foundation of the educational activities of the Samsthan. In the initial stages, the Manik Vidyalaya had no independent structure to call its own. It was then run more along the lines of the Gurukuls of yore, as the classes were conducted in the courtyards of Temples in the village.

As he grew up, his then guardians, notably his loving mother Smt. Lakshmibai Saheb, thought it appropriate that he be schooled in a modern institution providing formal instruction and learning experiences to students and playing a key role in developing critical thinking, problem solving and other skills, accredited by the relevant national education authorities.

For this purpose, they chose the famed Scindia School of Gwalior. Smt. Lakshmibai Saheb steeled herself to part with her only son and send him almost 1200 Kms. away from Maniknagar, only so that he may receive a modern education which would mould him to serve the Samsthan and its surrounding region well.

Thus, it was that Shri Siddharaj Manik Prabhu Maharaj spent his formative years in the hallowed portals of The Scindia School of Gwalior. There he quickly became the favourite of his teachers and fellow students. Such was his dedication to his Samsthan and the region surrounding it that while studying in the Scindia School itself, he began dreaming of setting up such an institution on the soil of his beloved Maniknagar, so that this quality of education may be available to all the people of the region surrounding Maniknagar.
